WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO TO ENTER IN THE LUCKY DRAW?

1. Proceed to the Ticket Counter to purchase the Green ticket at \$30 (only one ticket can be purchased for each family member)
2. Collect your free White Complimentary ticket (only one ticket will be given to each family member)

(NOTE – At the end of all 14 Chadavas and Parna, if your Green ticket has not been called in the lucky draw, you can present your Green ticket to get a refund at full amount of \$30. If this is not collected by the end of the event-before 5.00 pm, this shall be considered as your contribution to Vitraag Jain Shwetambar Sangh for its upcoming events.)

PROCEEDINGS FOR EACH OF THE 14 SWAPNA

For each Supan, a draw of “Green” or “White” will be performed individually and this will be announced. Once selected for that particular chadava from the lucky draw, the person along with their family should proceed to the stage in order to perform the procedure.

- **JULAVANU:** (Green Ticket) Selected persons will get the honour to swing the *Swapna*.
- **PHOOL NI MALA:** (White Ticket) Selected persons will place the flower garland on the *Swapna* or the *Parnu*.
- **MOTI NI MALA:** (Green Ticket) Selected persons will place the pearl garland on the *Swapna*.
- **SONA NI MALA:** (Green Ticket) Selected persons will place the gold garland on the *Swapna*.
- **PADHRAVANU:** (Green Ticket) Selected persons will unite the *Swapna* from the pulley, display it to the Sangh for Darshan and put it back on the platform.

PROCEDURE FOR CHADAVA (IN SAUD)

- **TILAK** (The highest chadava will do “*Tilak*” on each person that enters the stage who has been selected by draw to perform the procedure)

- **JULAVANU: 4th – SHREE LAXMIJI.** The highest chadava will have the honour to swing the 4th *Swapna* Shree Laxmiji.
- **MOTI NI MALA: 4th – SHREE LAXMIJI.** The highest chadava will place the pearl garland on the 4th *Swapna* Shree Laxmiji.
- **SONA NI MALA: 4th – SHREE LAXMIJI.** The highest chadava will place the gold garland on the 4th *Swapna* Shree Laxmiji.
- **PADHRAVANU: 4th – SHREE LAXMIJI.** The highest chadava will have the honour to display the 4th *Swapna* Shree Laxmiji to Sangh for *Darshan* and to place it on the platform.
- **JULAVANU: 8th – DHARMA DHAJA.** The highest chadava will have the honour to swing the 8th *Swapna* Dharma Dhaja.
- **MOTI NI MALA: 8th – DHARMA DHAJA.** The highest chadava will place the pearl garland on the 8th *Swapna* Dharma Dhaja.
- **SONA NI MALA: 8th – DHARMA DHAJA.** The highest chadava will place the gold garland on the 8th *Swapna* Dharma Dhaja.
- **PADHRAVANU: 8th – DHARMA DHAJA.** The highest chadava will have the honour to display the 8th *Swapna* Dharma Dhaja to Sangh for *Darshan* and to place it on the platform.
- **AMI CHATNA** (for the 10th *Swapna*). The highest chadava will have the honour to spray Rose water on the entire Vitraag Jain Shwetambar Sangh. Rose Water and the other equipment will be provided)

PARNA CHADAVA DETAILS

- **BHAGWAN PADHRAVANU & ROOMAL** (The highest chadava will put Lord Mahavira in the cradle & will also place a specially designed Roomal on Lord Mahavira)
- **MOTI NI MALA** (The highest chadava will place the pearl garland on Lord Mahavira’s Parna.)
- **SONA NI MALA** (The highest chadava will place the gold garland on Lord Mahavira’s Parna.)
- **JULAVANU** (The highest chadava will have the honour of swaying Lord Mahavira’s Parna.)
- **“PARNA” TO BE TAKEN HOME** (The highest chadava will be allowed to take *Parna* home and keep it overnight.

The interested people for this Chadava must be aware of the following:

- *Labharthi* can invite the whole Sangh to their home for Darshan between 9-11 pm on the same night for Samuh Bhakti
- *Labharthi* will have to do *Prabhavna* to everyone that comes to their place for *Darshan* of *Parnu*
- Strict adherence to no serving of food or beverages to maintain purity of the function, according to Jainism rules.

For the *Labharthi* who may not have above arrangement at their home, Vitraag Jain Shwetambar Sangh can facilitate to conduct the ‘*Darshan*’ and ‘*Bhavna*’ at Netball Hall.

(NOTE – All garlands and the *Parna* will be provided by **VITRAAG JAIN SHWETAMBAR SANGH**)

For each of the 14 *Swapna*, four (4) draws will happen using the GREEN tickets draws and the *Phool ni Mala* draw will happen using the WHITE tickets, i.e. total sixty-three (63) as outlined by the following table
